

Vacuum Maintenance Guide

Daily Maintenance for Ermator Electric Vacuums

- Inspect pre-filters/sock filters and HEPA filters to make sure there are no holes, rips or leaks.
- Inspect wheels and casters to make sure they have not come loose and are tight.
- Inspect cords, wires, and plugs ends to make sure wires are tight and in the correct location.

Daily Maintenance for Ermator Propane Vacuum

- Inspect pre filter/sock filters and HEPA filters to make sure there are no holes, rips or leaks.
- Inspect wheels and casters to make sure they have not come loose and are tight.
- Inspect cords, wires, and throttle to make sure they are tight and in the correct location.
- Check oil level.
- Clean out engine air filter.
- Inspect battery to make sure it is secure at all times and wires are tight. Disconnect battery if transporting.

Notes About Filters & Longopacs

- HEPA filters last about 2,000 hours under normal conditions, but need to be inspected daily for leaks and holes.
- Pre-filters last about 1,000 hours under normal conditions, but need to be inspected daily for leaks and holes.
- Pre-filter and HEPA filter life can vary depending on maintenance and volume picked up.
- Longopacs are 72' long and bags are averaged at 3' long each, so one roll can handle about 24 bags. A box of longopacs comes with 4 rolls, with an average of 96 bags at 3' each bag.
